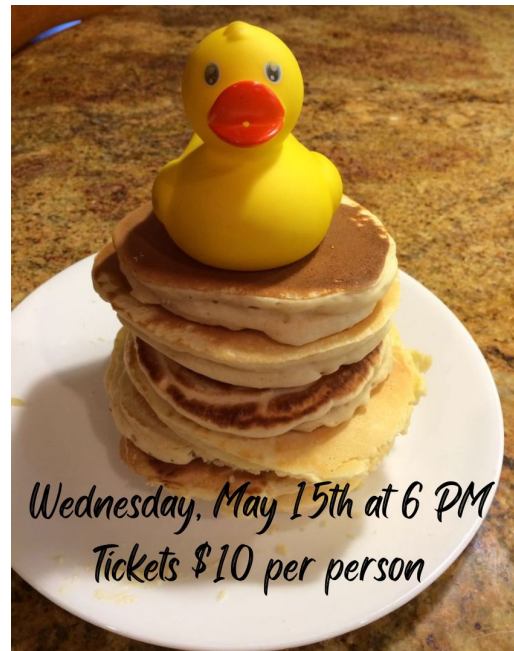
Confirmation Corner
